- D. Strength coaches may apply as affiliate members.

- F. Trainers may not make personal use of NATA logo. This is a violation of Code of Ethics.

  - Associate must be actively engaged in athletic training.

### III. Motions - New Business

- A. Warren Morris - University of Georgia  
It is the recommendation of District 9 that the Board of Directors meet at the end of the Convention for the voting part of their meeting. Seconded by George Camp; unanimous - no absentions.
- B. Jack Redgren - Vanderbilt University  
To improve the communications in the NATA, I move:  
Point One: We direct the Board to have an agenda to the Board of Directors six weeks prior to any national Board of Directors meeting so that the membership can review and discuss all agenda items, and;  
Point Two: Nothing new can be voted upon until the Directors report to their district meeting.  
Seconded by Warren Morris; unanimous.
- C. Roy Don Wilson - University of Kentucky  
I move that upon completion and acceptance of the Olympic Selection Committee representatives to the Board of Directors, that our Director move that this be accepted by the United States Olympic Committee or boycott; motion passed.
- D. Jack Redgren - Vanderbilt University  
I move that we direct Mr. Barton to go to the Board of Directors and state that District 9 is opposed to NATA becoming involved in the retail tape selling business. Unanimous - no absentions.
