- B. The associate member who plans to apply for Certification Exam under Section III must make written intention by January 1, 1977.
- C. District Meeting will be held on July 9-10. Discussion on meeting was held.
- D. Licensure Discussion and State Associations Committee in each state to push licensure. State associations would weaken the District Associations and National Association. Associate members will be grandfathered in so as not to put them out of work.
A state chapter implies no national organization. This will weaken the national association.
- Redgren made motion to have T. K. Wall, District Director, support action to not encourage formation of state associations for promoting licensure of trainers; sectioned by Barton; motion carried.
- Board will not support state associations. It will support chapters which would fall under the NATA umbrella. If you form a state association, you will not be recognized or supported by the national NATA.

- Jerry Rhea discussed how state of Georgia went about getting law passed.
