



## 2023 SEATA EducATion Experience

### Call for Proposals February 9 - 12, 2023

**Deadline for Proposal Submission:** September 15, 2022

The Research and Education Committee is excited to begin the planning process for the 2023 SEATA EducATion Experience which is scheduled for February 9 - 12. As we begin planning, we invite you to submit a session for the meeting that is focused on advancing clinical practice and improving patient outcomes. This year, the themes for the meeting include:

**Orthopedic Evaluation and Diagnosis**  
**Holistic Healthcare and Wellness**

Proposals are currently being accepted for the following presentation formats:

**Lecture Presentations:** 1-hour presentations with 1 speaker. These are in-depth presentations on one topic relevant to the interest of the membership and should be organized to fall within the domains of practice for athletic training.

**Learning Labs:** Combination of short lectures and hands-on laboratory sessions. Learning labs may be a 90-minute session or a 20-minute lecture with repeating 50-minute lab sessions. Presentations must fall within the domains of practice for athletic training.

**Pre- or Post-Conference Workshops:** 4 or 8-hour workshop with a format determined by the presenter.

**Special Topics/open format:** 1-hour sessions featuring a lecture presentation and possible interactive discussion with 1 speaker. These sessions do not provide participatory hands-on activities. Presentations must fall within the domains of practice for athletic training.
