- III. Old Business
 - A. Motion to accept minutes of 1968 meetings by Don Fauls; seconded by Tom Simmons; carried unanimously.
 - B. Motion to accept Treasurer's report by Don Fauls and seconded by Tom Simmons. Carried.
 - C. Motion made to align the dues structure of District 9 to conform with the national structure dating from January 1 to January 1 made by Warren Ariail; seconded by Wes Knight. Carried.
 - D. Motion to make a 4-year term of office for the post of Secretary-Treasurer, District 9 NATA with the provision that the Secretary-Treasurer may relinquish his office at the end of 4 years. District Secretary shall be automatically up for renomination at the District 9 meeting in June, 1973. Motion made by Leroy Mullins and seconded by Don Fauls. Carried.
- IV. New Business
 - A. Director Patrick directed all members to send in the Biographical Forms to the Secretary-Treasurer.
 - B. Twenty-five year award and Hall of Fame award 1970--no one eligible from District 9.
 - C. Director Patrick encouraged all members to contact new men so that we may increase our membership.
 - D. Mickey Cobb formally appointed Editor of the District Newsletter by Director Patrick.
 - E. The Secretary-Treasurer requested all members to advise him of job changes.
 - F. There will be a Placement Booth at each yearly meeting.
 - G. The 1973 convention will be hosted by District 9 in Atlanta.
 - H. 1970 dues are placed at \$30; \$20 of which will go toward national dues; the remaining \$10 will be for District 9 dues.
 - I. At the Board of Directors meeting on June 7 the Certification Committee's proposal was approved regarding the proposed test for the certification of all incoming members. A Grandfather Clause was included. This was reported by Director Patrick.
